This study aims to determine the optimistic phase of culture in overseas students, the phase of cultural problems in overseas students, the phase of cultural recovery in overseas students, and the phase of cultural adjustment in overseas students.

This study uses qualitative research methods with a qualitative descriptive study research approach. The research subjects were overseas students who were studying in the city of Bandung and were determined purposively based on cultural communication.
